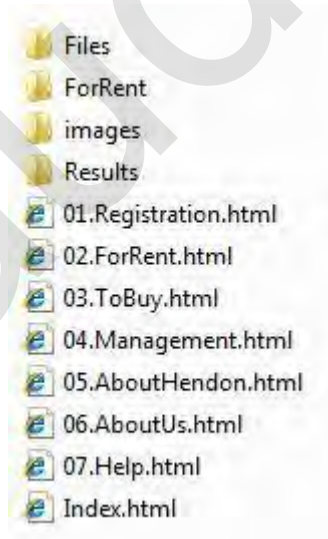

Folder Structure

The website site contains four folders. The main pages are at the root of the website and they are numbered according to the order they have in the main navigation menu, this is to facilitate the location of the page for the designer; the only page in the root menu that does not need a number at the front in the index.html.



The four folder of the website are the following:

1. - Files

Contain two files, the “FormValidation.js” and the “style.css”. The JavaScript file is imported into the html files that contains a form, while the Cascade Style Sheet file is imported on every page of the website and provides the design of the site, font colour and div separation.

2. - ForRent

This folder contains three pages, the three properties that are available for renting, displaying the location, price and a form that the user can fill in to get further information.

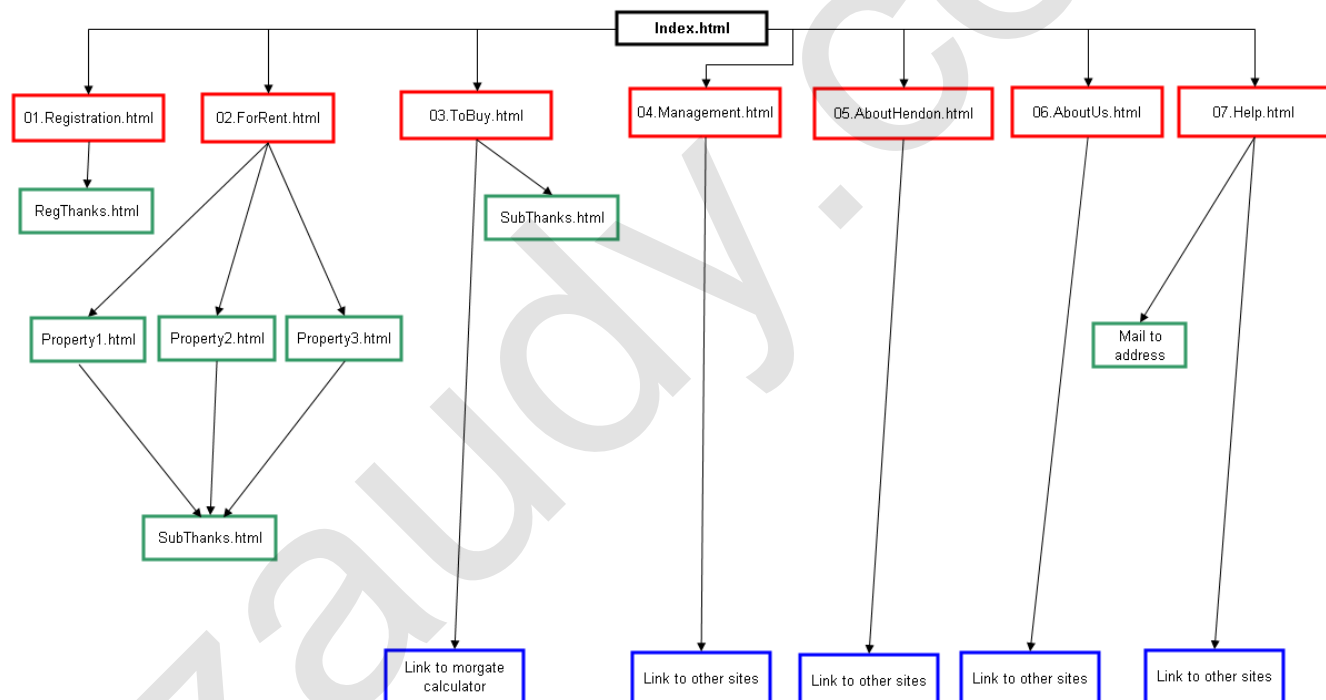
3. - images
